Announcing our 1st Annual “Pete Dye Society Legacy Classic”, to be played at the world-class Casa de Campo Resort in the Dominican Republic!

Casa de Campo held a special place in Pete Dye’s heart, having designed 4 courses on the property. Pete loved it so much that the latter half of his life he made it his permanent residence. The most famous of his designs is the Teeth of the Dog—consistently rated in the Top 100 courses globally (and where Pete’s remains are buried next to hole #8).

The Legacy Classic will include an 18-hole practice round (Teeth of the Dog), a non-competitive ‘fun’ round (Dye Links), and a 36-hole tournament playing two different courses (Dye Fore and Teeth of the Dog).

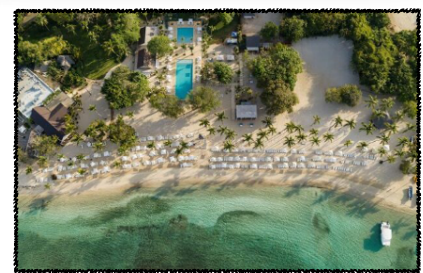

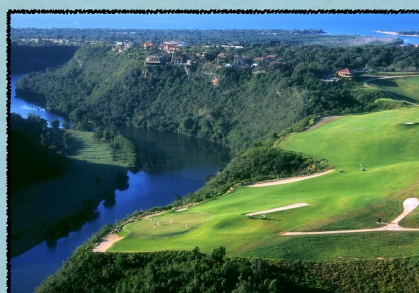

Dye Fore: Rated the 5th best course in the Dominican (and 17th in the Caribbean), this hidden gem has wide fairways, tough Dye green complexes, and sweeping views of the Chavon River and Casa de Campo Marina!



Dye Links: Rated the 10th best course in the Dominican (and 40th in the Caribbean), this favorite of locals will test you with Dye’s routing through inland lakes.

About Casa de Campo

Casa de Campo is a world-class 5-star resort with top notch dining and services. A massive 7,000 acre resort, each room gets a golf cart for getting around to the many fun and exciting locations throughout the resort (shuttles make a loop around the resort as well—but golf carting is the primary mode of transportation).

There are 4 unique areas of the resort:

Main Resort: where the Elite Rooms are located and where check-in occurs. This area has multiple restaurants, bars, pools with swim-up bars, workout facility, full-service spa, shopping, and the pro shop for Teeth of the Dog and Dye Links golf courses.

Minitas Beach: this is the resort's private beach area, which includes multiple dining options, shopping, pools, bars, beach chairs/umbrellas, and other beach activities. A great place to hang out, drink and swim.

La Marina: this is the resort's massive marina, east of Minitas Beach that contains multiple restaurants and bars, shopping mall, grocery store, movie theater and boat excursions.

Altos de Chavon: a hidden gem at the resort, this 16th century Italian Village

overlooking a massive bluff upon the Chavon River. has cobblestone roads, restaurants, bars, shopping, the Dye Fore pro shop, and an outdoor Roman amphitheater, this is must-see area of the resort

Schedule of Events

Sat 11/14: Arrivals and Check-in. Opening Ceremony Dinner at Minitas Beach Club (golfers and non-golfers invited). Special guest speakers during Opening Ceremony!

Sun 11/15: After breakfast, play an optional 18-hole practice round at Teeth of the Dog! Have lunch and dinner at the many gourmet restaurants!

Mon 11/16 (Day 1 of Tourney): After breakfast, play 18-holes at Dye Fore. Have lunch and dinner at the many gourmet restaurants

Tue 11/17: A relaxing day off. There will be an optional 'fun/non-competitive' round at Dye Links.

Wed 11/18 (Day 2 of Tourney): After breakfast, play 18-holes at Teeth of the Dog! Closing Ceremony/Awards Dinner at La Piazzeta at Altos de Chavon.

Thurs 11/19: After breakfast, pack up and get ready for departure shuttles back to the airport!

GOLF TOURNAMENT

The **Pete Dye Society Legacy Classic** is a two-day, 36-hole stroke play 'social yet competitive' tournament which will use a Stableford scoring system. There will be prizes for Gross and Net division winners for both Men and Women. All golfers can also partake in an optional practice round at Teeth of the Dog and a non-competitive round at Dye Links. Caddies are required at Teeth of the Dog and Dye Fore (optional at Dye Links). Caddie fees are \$50/cart + tip.

ACTION REQUIRED: Registration opens in Late January on the Casa de Campo website under 'Golf Tournaments'. A \$500 deposit (non-refundable) per person is due at registration (balance due on arrival). With only 60 entries allowed, this event will fill up fast!!

FOR NON-GOLFERS

Non-Golfers will never be bored! While golf is going on you can explore everything the Resort has to offer, including the beach, pools, and swim-up bars. You also get a free 1-day spa pass that includes a 50 minute massage!

Besides the four main areas of the resort, Casa de Campo has a world-class Shooting Center, Equestrian Center, Racquet Center, Polo Grounds, and Convention Center.
